1. Flower beds & planters + tools - Outside	Cash donations for purchase of items specifically for resident activities in the courtyards

3. Small Greenhouse	Must be accessible by wheelchair, suggested placement, just beyond deck near cafeteria entrance
4. Stereo System + Karaoke machine	Plus karaoke discs with tunes from 1940s to present
5. Fishing Equipment	Poles, reels, tackle, bait

7. New CD's & DVD's	Recent and classic titles of all genres
8. Stained glass for chapel	Cash donations to support this effort
9. Magazine subscriptions	Wings, Airpower, Time, Newsweek, Audubon Society, Motor Trend CLASSIC, Civil War History, WWII History, plus various other subjects, as requested

10. Cat's Meow wooden models of DVH	commission Cat's Meow or other manufacturer to develop wooden replica of Home to be sold by future gift shop
11. Adaptive Equipment for personal computers	Enable computer/phone use by Paraquadriplegics, blind and hearing impaired...for use in the library
12. Personal Computers and printers – complete systems	3 new PCs and 1 printer for library, one PC to function as server exclusive of state network. Other PCs and printers (new or reconditioned) to be donated to individual residents who wish to have personal computer in their room but can not afford one.
